CHANGE ORDER DESCRIPTION: This change order adds five (5) new items to compensate the contractor for the additional work required to facilitate construction beneath the Council Road bridge in the median of the John Kilpatrick Turnpike. The 'Class AA Concrete', 'Removal of Cable Barrier', 'Installation of Cable Barrier System', and 'End Anchors' items are added to compensate the contractor for the removal and reinstallation of the existing cable barrier in the median of the turnpike. This is necessary for the contractor to construct the bridge widening for the Council Road bridge over the turnpike. The 'Arrow Display (Type C)' item is added to meet the MUTCD specifications for the required lane closures throughout the duration of the project, which was otherwise unaccounted for in the plans. This change order compensates the contractor for all labor, maintenance, materials, equipment, incidentals, and time required to complete this work.

TURNPIKE REPORT

March 2026

For the month of March, troopers made 5,969 violator contacts, assisted 1,294 motorists, and investigated 165 motor vehicle collisions with three fatalities reported. Troopers worked 1,281 shifts and averaged 229 miles per shift for a total of 293,373 miles driven.

The Turnpike System reported three fatalities for the month of March.

Indian Nation Turnpike – The driver was killed when the vehicle caught fire after striking a semi in the rear that was parked on the shoulder of the road.

Kickapoo Turnpike – The driver was killed after striking another vehicle with a trailer in the rear and ending up directly under the trailer.

H.E. Bailey Turnpike – The driver was killed when the vehicle departed the roadway, hit the guardrail and went down an embankment.

Special Emphasis troopers worked 17 shifts on the Muskogee, Indian Nation and the Creek Turnpikes and contacted 396 violators. These troopers issued 76 citations and 320 warnings for an average of 23.3 contacts per shift.

No Drug Interdictions.

The aircraft enforcement flew a total of 0 hours.

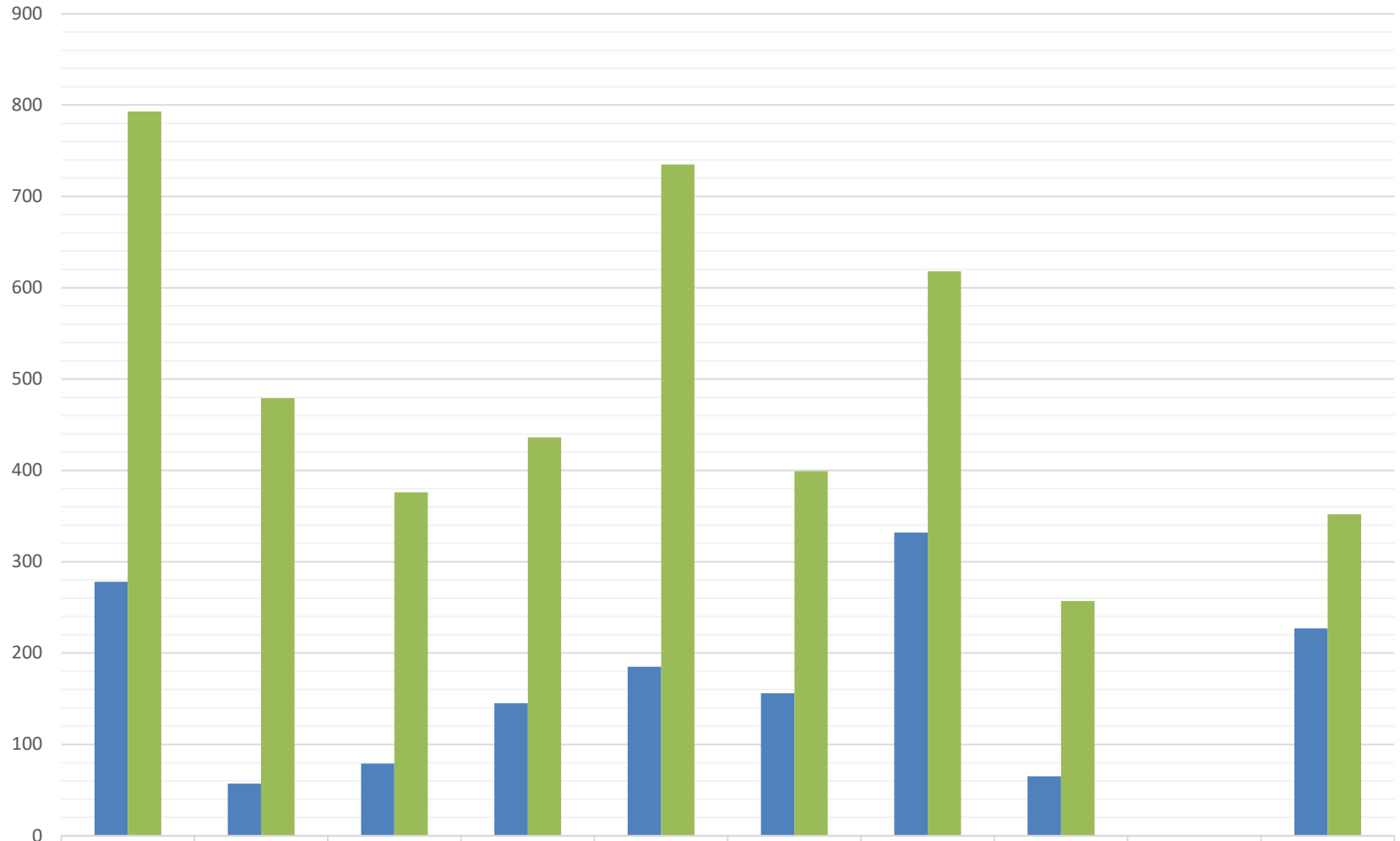

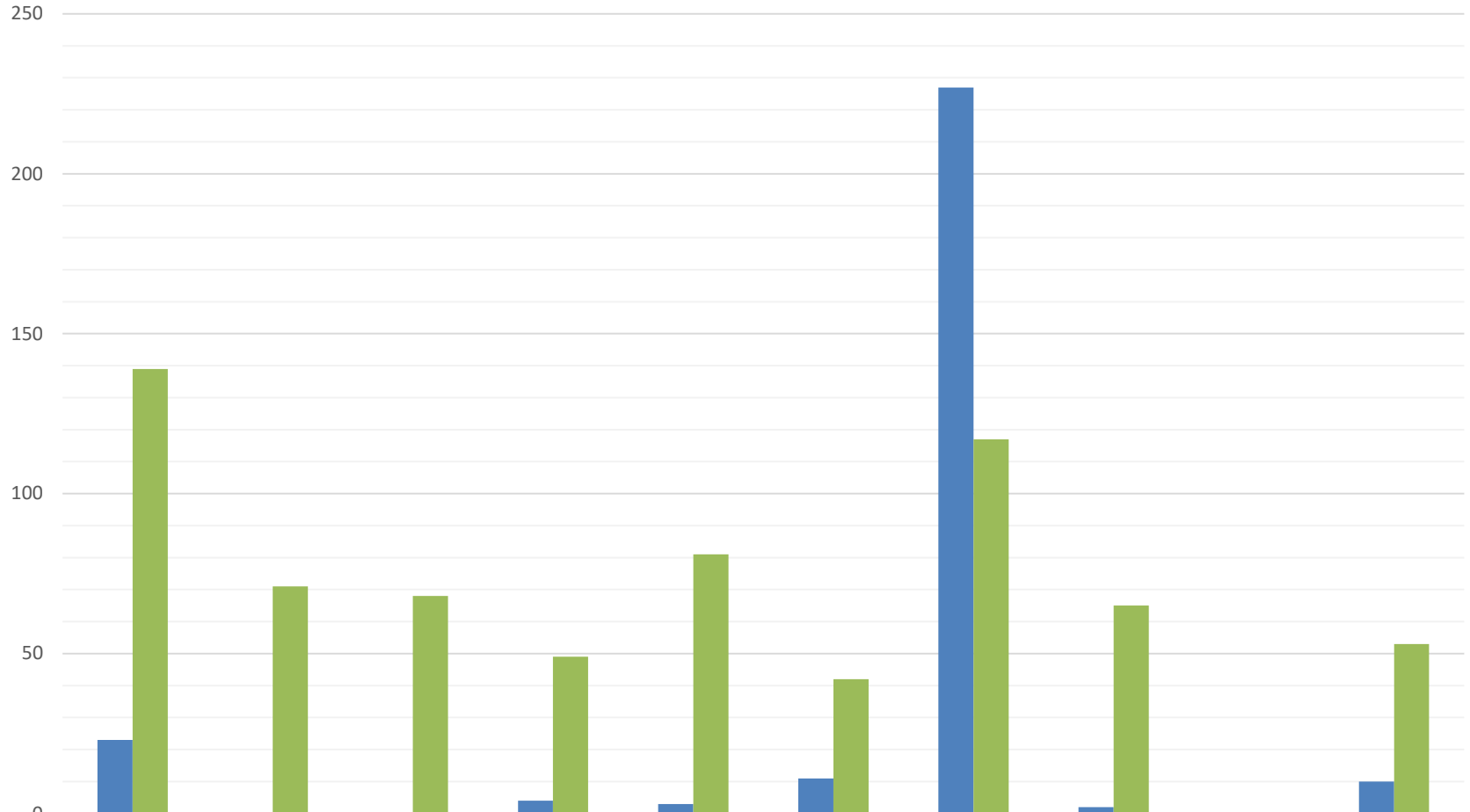

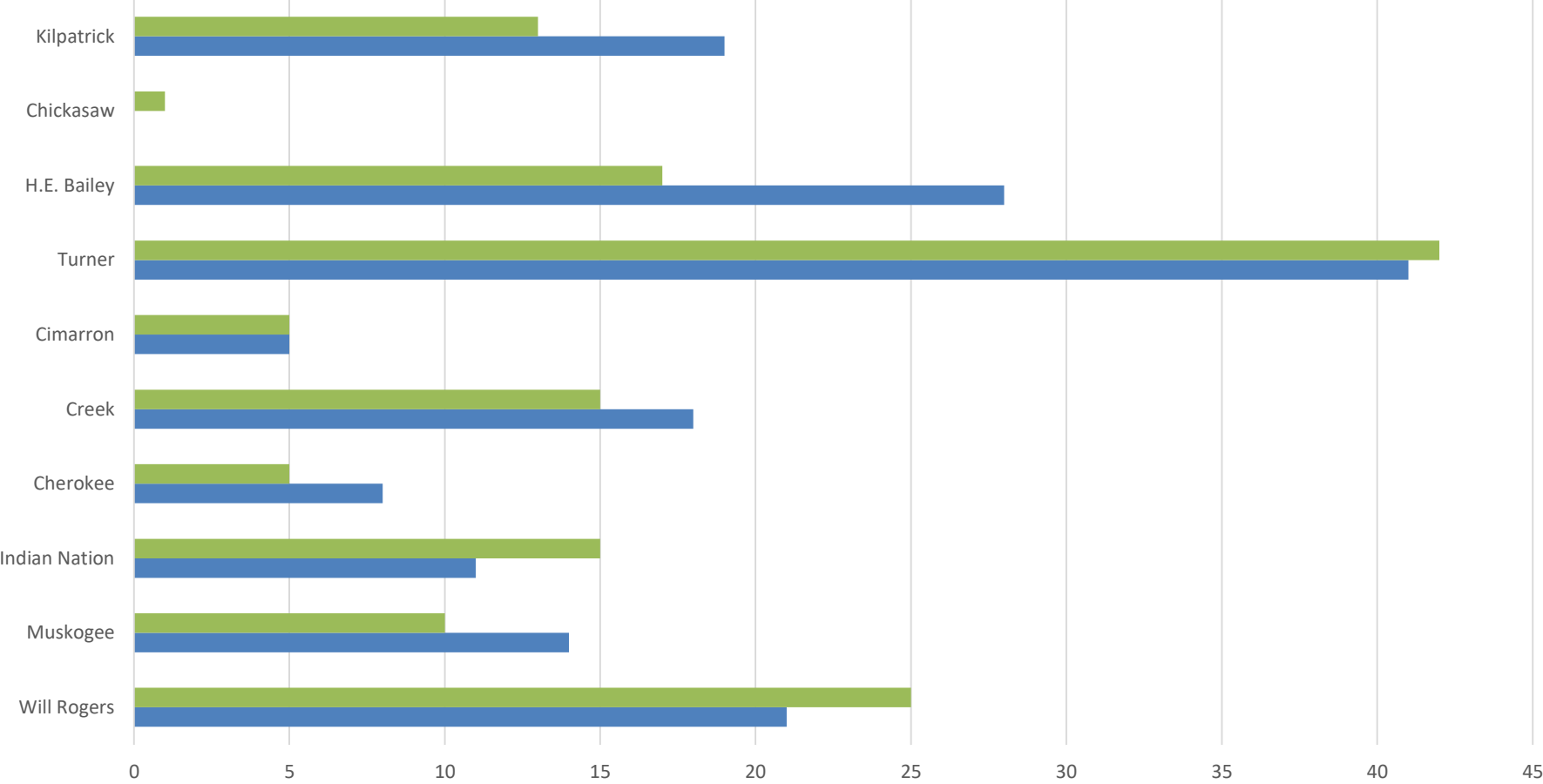

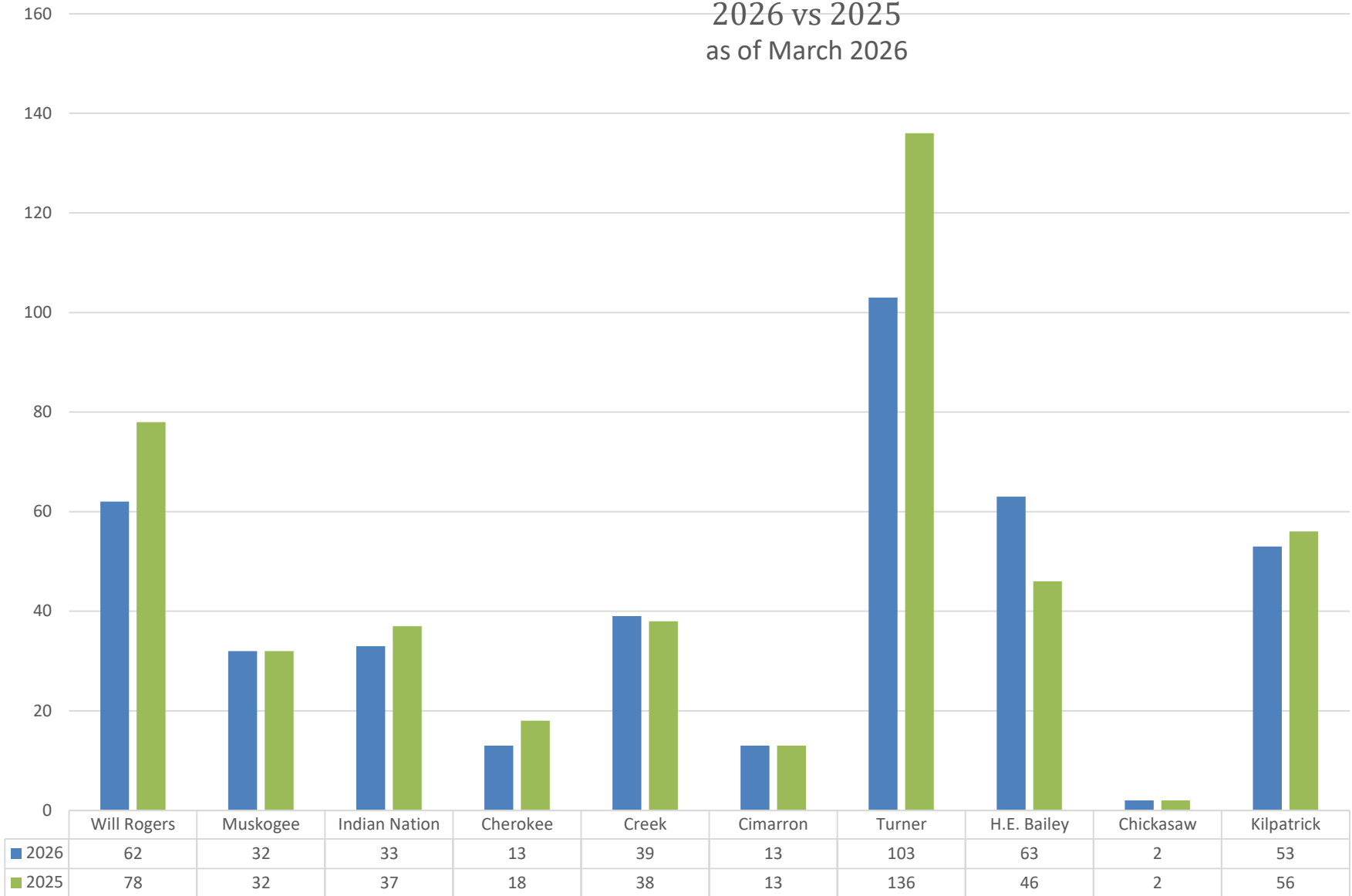

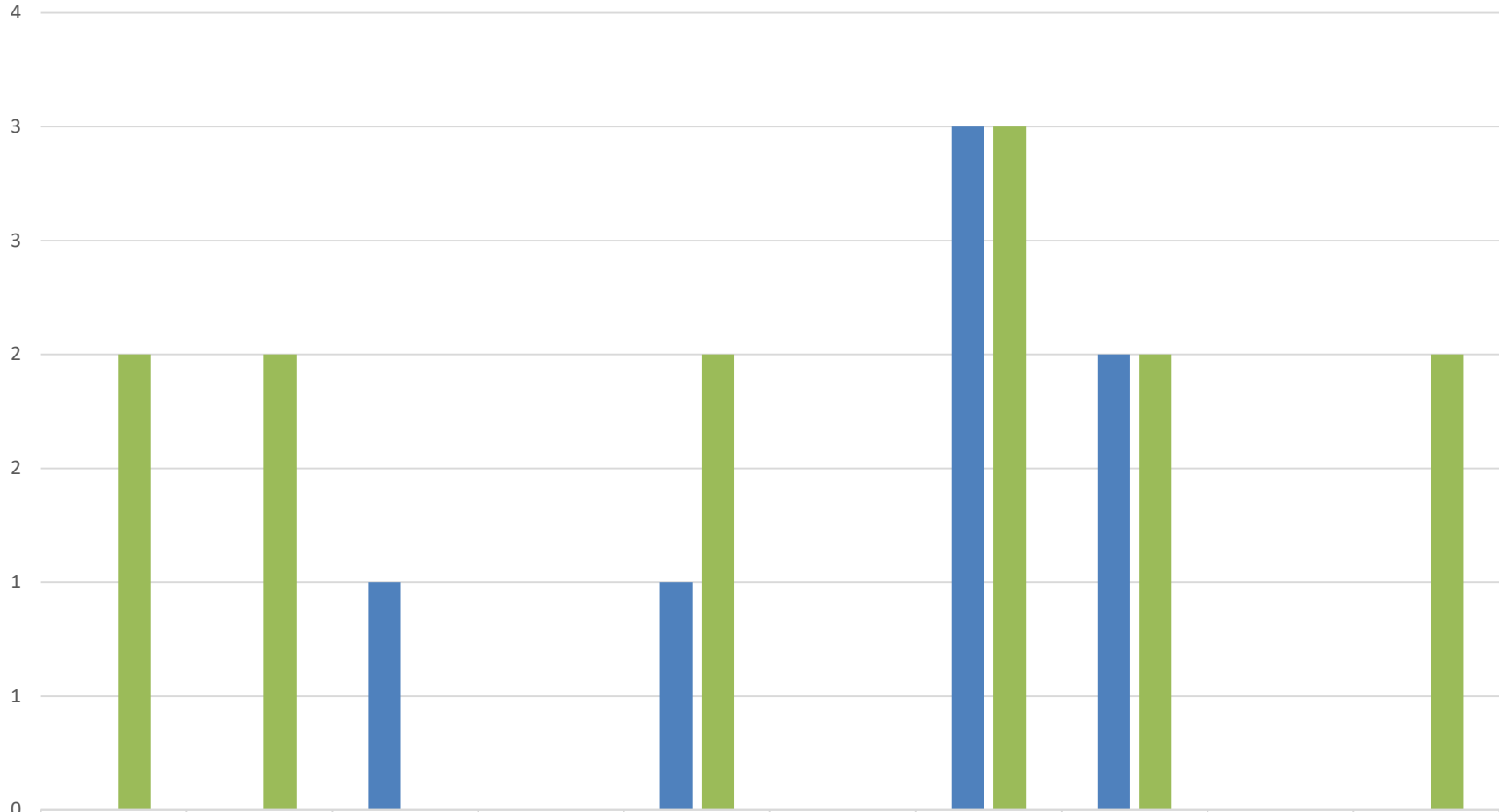
